To Whom It May Concern:

I sourced Neuron Learning through an advertisement on a local paper in June 2005. Initially, John invited us to the centre for an initial screening and discussed how the programme would benefit my ten-year-old Son. I was impressed the Dyslexia Association of Ireland supports Neuron Learning as a teaching tool and I went ahead with the programme.

My Son was diagnosed with dyslexic tendencies in March 2005. Up until then he had trouble with reading and writing, he was anxious and withdrawn and he became upset and tearful easily. This of course had traumatic effects on my family and it impeded on my Son's relationships with peers and family members as he lost confidence in himself and others.

Neuron Learning has changed all our lives! My son is brighter, more confident, alert, enthusiastic and generally optimistic. He is thriving emotionally, socially and cognitively and the improvements in his writing and reading skills are overwhelming. I pinch myself when I think back to the pressures we endured before we commenced the programme.

I acknowledge both John and Joyce for their respect towards my son and for their persistence and their constant appraisal of his efforts.

For me, the cost of the programme is minimal in comparison with the visible results and peace of mind.
